We are very mindful that we want to produce an event of the same quality as last years. Our aim is to exceed expectations year on year as we get bigger and better. Given the magnitude of the event set up and preparations involved it would not be possible to hold off making a decision until the very last minute.

Although things are slowly improving in the fight against Covid:19, there is a lot of uncertainty on large gatherings. It is very unlikely any events with a large footfall and social distancing guidelines will go forward this year.

After closely evaluating the on going risks and uncertainty, as well as any additional pressures a large event would put on the nhs emergency services we have consulted with everyone involved and a decision was made to reschedule the event.

The new date has been secured for Saturday September 11th 2021 at Campbell Park.

Now that our main event has been rescheduled we will continue to work closely with The Parks Trust in the hope that we could provide a small scale event for the local LGBTQ+ community of Milton Keynes. Pending government guidelines.
